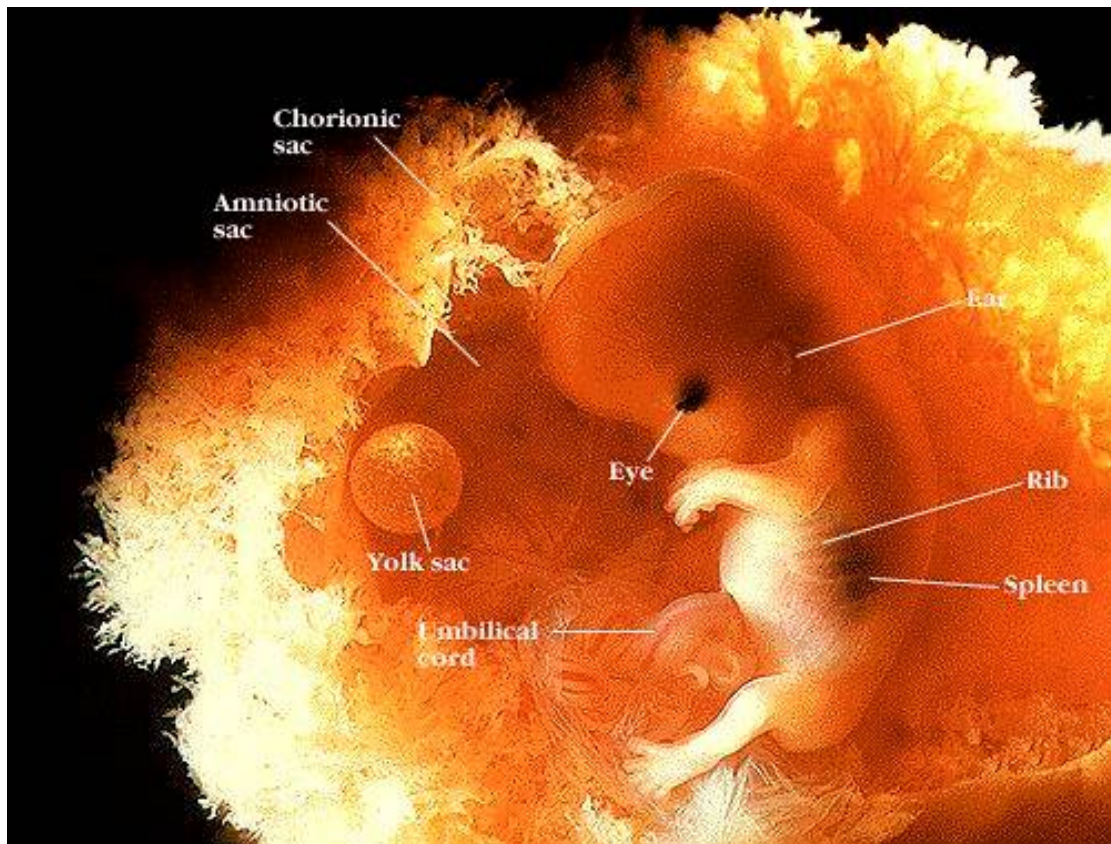


12 Weeks

Great men are not always wise, nor do the aged always understand justice.
(Job 32:9)



And the fourth was named Penemue; he taught the children of men the bitter and the sweet, and he taught them all the secrets of their wisdom. 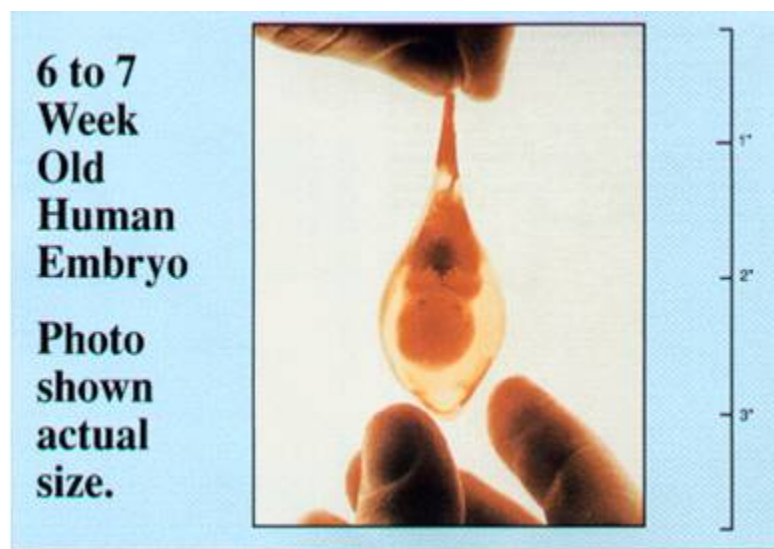

A child's growth according to medical research

The baby's heart begins beating between 18 and 24 days, even before the mother knows she is pregnant. The baby moves his arms and legs at 6 weeks. At 43 days his brain waves can be read, his heart is beating sturdily, his stomach produces digestive juices, the liver produces blood cells.

The baby is surrounded by water which is called the amniotic sac. He lives, breathes and swims in this amniotic fluid. At eight weeks the baby opens his mouth and drinks the fluid. Tests have shown when a needle is inserted into the amniotic sac and the point sticks the baby he feels pain and immediately moves away from the needle. Further tests have shown that if a sweet solution is added to the fluid he drinks more; but if a sour or bitter solution is added, he drinks much less.



At 8 weeks the baby is completely formed: all of his organs are functioning, he even urinates and has his very own finger prints. At this age he does feel pain, he kicks his legs, moves his feet and tiny toes and fingers, even makes a strong fist.



At 11 weeks he sucks his thumb, and has his fingernails. The placenta continues to supply food and oxygen, the child can make complex facial expressions and even smile. All bodily systems are becoming more efficient.



At 12 weeks pregnant, your baby is 2.2 inches long and weighs up to half an ounce! Your baby continues to grow and develop tremendously during pregnancy week 12. You'll be amazed at the pregnancy week by week changes that will start occurring within your baby in the upcoming months. Your baby's genitals will start showing signs of being either male or female soon. During pregnancy week 12, your baby's brain is starting to make hormones, and nerve cells are multiplying at a rapid rate. Your baby may be sucking as early as this week, and your baby's kidneys may even be producing urine.

At 16 weeks, only 5 ½ inches long, the child can use hands to grasp, can swim and turn somersaults.

The 18 week old child is active and energetic, flexes muscles, punches and kicks. Now the mother feels the child's movements. Before modern science, some said that at this time - the time of "quickenings" - life begins. But the child's development actually began at conception, 18 weeks earlier.

Summary

Day one	Conception.
One week	Attaches to wall of womb.
Two weeks	Stops mother's menstrual period.
Three weeks	Heart is beating.
Six weeks	Brain waves measurable. Moves and responds to touch.
8 weeks	Heartbeat can be heard on office ultrasonic stethoscope. Heart has been beating for one month. EKG -- electrocardiogram can be done. Brain Waves -- were measurable 2 weeks ago. Feels Pain -- and responds to touch. Sucks Thumb. Grasps -- instrument paged in his/her palm. Swims -- with a natural swimmer's stroke.
2½ months	Body completely formed, even fingerprints.
3 months	All organ systems functioning.
After three months	Nothing new develops or functions. There is only growth in size and maturity.

Your hands have made me and fashioned me, an intricate unity; yet You would destroy me. Remember, I pray, that You have made me like clay. And will you turn me into dust again? Did You not pour me out like milk, and curdle me like cheese, clothe me with skin and flesh, and knit me together with bones and sinews? And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, when as yet there were none of them. (Psa 139:13-16)

The LORD said to her, "Two countries are in your womb. Two nations will go their separate ways from birth. One nation will be stronger than the other, and the older will serve the younger." (Gen 25:23)

Didn't He who made me in my mother's belly make them? Didn't the same God form us in the womb? (Job 31:15)

Indeed, you are the one who brought me out of the womb, the one who made me feel safe at my mother's breasts. I was placed in your care from birth. From my mother's womb you have been my God. (Psa 22:9-10)

Even inside the womb wicked people are strangers to God. From their birth liars go astray. (Psa 58:3)

I depended on you before I was born. You took me from my mother's womb. My songs of praise constantly speak about you. (Psa 71:6)

The Lord made you, formed you in the womb, and will help you. This is what the Lord says: "Don't be afraid, my servant Jacob, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen." (Isa 44:2)

The LORD reclaimed you. He formed you in the womb. This is what the LORD says: I, the LORD, made everything. I stretched out the heavens by myself. I spread out the earth all alone. (Isa 44:24)

Listen to me, you islands. Pay attention, you people far away. Before I was born, the LORD chose me. While I was in my mother's womb, He recorded my name. (Isa 49:1)

The LORD formed Me in the womb to be His servant in order to bring Jacob back to Him and gather Israel to Him. The LORD honors Me, and My God has become My strength. (Isa 49:5)

Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations." (Jer 1:4-5)

Hear the word of the Lord, you children of Israel, for the Lord brings a charge against the inhabitants of the land: "There is no truth or mercy or knowledge of God in the land. By swearing and lying, killing and stealing and committing adultery, they break all restraint, with bloodshed upon bloodshed." (Hos 4:1-2)

"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children. The more they increased, the more they sinned against Me; I will change their glory into shame. They eat up the sin of My people; they set their heart on their iniquity. And it shall be: like people, like priest. So I will punish them for their ways, and reward them for their deeds. For they shall eat, but not have enough; they shall commit harlotry, but not increase; because they have ceased obeying the Lord." (Hos 4:6-10)

"They do not direct their deeds toward turning to their God, for the spirit of harlotry is in their midst, and they do not know the Lord." (Hos 5:4)

At the time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Whoever receives one little child like this in My name receives Me. But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea. Woe to the world because of offenses! For offenses must come, but woe to that man by whom the offense comes! If your hand or foot causes you to sin, cut it off and cast it from you. It is better for you to enter into life lame or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet, to be cast into the everlasting fire. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you. It is better for you to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire." (Mat 18:1-9)

Take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that in heaven their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven. For the Son of Man has come to save that which was lost. What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them goes astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine and go to the mountains to seek the one that is straying? And if he should find it, assuredly, I say to you, he rejoices more over that sheep than over the ninety-nine that did not go astray. Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish. (Mat 18:10-14)

Then little children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and pray, but the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven." And He laid His hands on them and departed from there. (Mat 19:13-15)

Then He came to Capernaum. And when He was in the house He asked them, "What was it you disputed among yourselves on the road?" But they were silent, for on the road they had disputed among themselves who would be the greatest. And He sat down, called the twelve, and said to them, "If anyone desires to be first, he shall be last of all and servant of all." Then He took a little child and set him in the midst of them. And when He had taken him in His arms, He said to them, "Whoever receives one of these little children in My name receives Me; and whoever receives Me, receives not Me but Him who sent Me." (Mar 9:33-37)

Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them. (Mar 10:13-16)
