

Benchmarks for this Creation

1. Our Saviour

Five thousand nine hundred and eighty six years ago, there was only a large sphere of water in a big black void, which we call Space. Then Our Father said, "Let there be Light" and His Light was manifest in that darkness. Our Father also appointed that Light, which is His Word, as The Saviour for all the people He would create (Isaiah 1:18-20 & 48:16-18 & 63:1-6).

2. Creation Sabbath

In just 6x 24h days Our Father created everything. The 7th day was the Sabbath day of rest and from this first week, we have the pattern for this seven thousand year creation. We know the first week was seven 24h days, because Adam was only 130y when he acquired Seth, his third son.

3. Adam

Adam was created on the 6th day and he died 930 years later, because he had sinned. The Lord had warned him that if he ate from the Tree of Knowledge he would die in the 'day' that he sinned. He died 70 years before the end of the 'day' and the 70 years has been a unit of measure as the Israelites punishment for disobedience. The Israelites were in Egypt for 210 years (Exodus 2448AM) and they were exiled in Babylon for 70 years. This is 4 x 70y units of disobedience for turning their backs on the Lord, as Adam and Eve had done in the Garden of Eden by disobeying His commandment.

4. Noah

Noah was born in 1056AM and he was 600 years old when the flood came. From this we know that the Genesis Flood happened in 1656AM.

5. Abraham

Abraham was born in 1948AM and he left Ur of Babylon when he was 52y so we know that this was the year 2000AM. Noah died when Abraham was 58y. Abraham had lived with Noah for forty years, from the age of 10 until he turned 50, which is how he understood righteousness.

6. King Asa

The fifteenth year of King Asa's reign was the year 3000AM and in that year they held a huge revival and all those who would not seek the Lord were put to death. (2Chronicles 15:10-15)

7. Crucifixion (Ordained before the foundation of the Earth)

This was the event which had been ordained before Creation. It took place in 4000AM and was patterned after the sacrificial lamb in Exodus 12:1-6 which was chosen on the tenth and killed on the fourteenth at twilight, four days later.

By this single sacrifice mankind is saved from sin and restored in God's image, for all those who willingly accept His sacrificial death on the Cross.

8. Barley Harvest (Gentiles)

This is known as the 1st Resurrection (Rapture) when the righteous dead are resurrected to meet the Lord in the air. The righteous living also meet the Lord in the air and all those people are taken to Heaven. This takes place just as Philip was snatched away (harpazo) from the Eunuch in Act 8:39. One minute he is witnessing to the Eunuch and the next he is gone. We don't know when this event will take place, but it will be some time before 6000AM.

9. Wheat Harvest (Jews)

This is the year 6000AM when the Lord returns for the 144000 law-keeping Jews mentioned in Revelation 7:4-8. The Lord then kills all of unrighteous humanity (Rev 14:14-20 **Vintage** & Rev 19). The Beast and the false prophet are thrown into the Lake of Fire and Satan is bound for the 1000y Sabbath. The millennial Sabbath begins with all the righteous in Heaven, and the unrighteous in Hell.

10. Judgement Day

After the millennial Sabbath - 7000AM, the Lord returns to Earth with all His Saints, and the unrighteous are resurrected (every eye - Rev 1:7) to see His glorious return. The unrighteous are judged and thrown into the Lake of Fire along with the Satan, Hell and Death, and everything else which is sinful.

11. Re-Creation

The Lord recreates Heaven and Earth without a sea. Creation will be restored to a sinless and pure state and only then does the New Jerusalem (Holy City) descend from Heaven down onto the New Earth (Rev 21).
