

7000 Year Creation

Trying to find someone to share what I have discovered has proven quite difficult. Therefore I have written this explanation so those who are interested, may read it freely for themselves. Please prove everything for yourself by scripture from the Holy Bible, that you may boldly defend your faith in GOD with confidence.

There is only one GOD, He is Good and has the best intention for His Creation. This world as we presently know it, is the first version which is designed to exist for only 7000 years. It is designed to produce many righteous children for GOD, which are His inheritance, and each individual has been given a fair choice.

One cannot be sure if someone really loves you, if you don't give them the option to freely choose whether they will or not. We have all been given the choice to love righteousness. The consequence of this choice is either eternal life or death, so choose wisely. We are able to make this choice right up until the moment of our death. It is a free choice and only requires our full commitment. The thief on the Cross couldn't even raise his hand for Christ, and yet he received salvation.

Before GOD created everything, the Plan of Salvation for Mankind was already established and The Word of GOD (Jesus Christ) was appointed to pay the price for our sin. As people cannot pay the price for their sins GOD has done this for us.

We are standing at the edge of eternity. What is 6000 years compared to eternity? People today talk about the Earth as being millions of years old, this is nonsense! If one is a believer in GOD's Word, they know that Genesis states that the Earth is less than 6000 years old. I will explain how the Bible describes the past and the future, according to my understanding of the scriptures.

In the Beginning GOD created light on the first day. Can anything survive and thrive without light? Could a star have previously existed if GOD only created light on the first day? There was darkness and then there was light. All plants and trees etc. were created on the third day. The sun was only created on the fourth day, and how long could all the vegetation survive without the sun?

Those first six days of special creation were 24h periods as we know them, and we call them days. If the periods were not 24h days they would have no meaning to us. Together with the Sabbath day of rest, they established the period of time we call a week. This week period is not defined anywhere else. It is the orbit of the moon, the Earth's spin and orbit around the Sun, which gives us the measure of months, days and years. The stars position allow for navigation, the measure of night-hours and also the thousands of years, due to precession of the Earth's axis of rotation, which takes 26000 years to complete just one circle.

If one uses the information in Genesis 5&11, we can calculate that Noah was born 1056 years after Adam was created (1056AM anno mundi in the year of the world). Shem the second son of Noah was born when Noah was 502y of age (Genesis 11:10). Shem lived 600y and died 35y after Abraham. He knew the Earth as it was before the flood (1656AM Genesis 7:11) also after the flood had caused it's global destruction. Shem was the person called 'Melchizedek' (King of righteousness) who met Abraham in Genesis 14:18 (see the title Adoni-zedek 'Lord of righteousness' in Joshua 10:1). The events of Genesis 15 took place before Genesis 12, as Abraham had made his covenant when he was 70y of age.

Paul knew this as he wrote; "And this I say, that the law, which was four hundred and thirty years later, cannot annul the covenant that was confirmed before by GOD in Christ, that it should make the promise of no effect." (Galatians 3:17)

Abraham had to wait 30y before his promised son of Sarah, Isaac was born. The period of time which had to elapse before his descendants returned to Canaan was 400y according to the covenant as stated in Genesis 15:13.

Abraham was born in 1948AM. He left Ur of the Chaldeans when he was 52y which was the year 2000AM. He lived with his family at Haran until he was 55y when the Lord spoke to him for the first time. Abraham left Haran with his wife and went to live as a stranger in the land of Canaan. He lived there until he was 70y and after he had made the covenant with the Lord (Genesis 15) he went back to Haran to visit his family. Abraham remained there 5y until the Lord spoke to him again, now this was 20y after the Lord had first told him to leave Haran and go to the land of Canaan. Abraham was 75y old and this time he took Lot and 70 converts of faith and their families with him, when they left Haran for the second time. Note that Genesis 12 begins with, "Now the LORD had said to Abram".

Isaac was born in 2048AM when Abraham was 100y and Sarah 90y old. Isaac was 60y when Jacob was born and Jacob was 130y when he entered Egypt. The Israelites were in Egypt for 210y and they left Egypt with Moses to return to Canaan 400y after Shem was born, in 2448AM. $60 + 130 + 210 = 400y$

The Israelites spied out the land of Canaan for 40 days and when they refused to enter, the Lord gave them the punishment of wandering around the desert for 40y. This meant they only crossed the Jordan with Joshua in 2488AM. However there were twelve tribes of Israel and it was 12x 40y before they settled down properly, when Solomon began to build the first Temple for the LORD.

"And it came to pass in the four hundred and eightieth year after the children of Israel had come out of the land of Egypt, in the fourth year of Solomon's reign over Israel, in the month of Ziv, which is the second month, that he began to build the house of the LORD." (1Kings 6:1) this was the year 2928AM.

Note the revival that took place in 3000AM described in 2Chronicles 14:1-15:19.

The kings of Judah reigned and Israel became corrupt and further from the Lord. They were taken into exile to Babylon for another period of 70y. It was 500y from Solomon building the first temple until they began to build the second Temple under the orders of King Cyrus. I calculated this period two ways, one by adding the years that each king of Judah reigned, also by the prophesy of Ezekiel 4. 390y for Judah and 40y for Israel, plus the 70y of captivity equals 500y in total.

In scripture there are also periods of time defined, called weeks of years. Every seventh year was a Sabbath rest for the land and it was not to be worked. After a period of seven weeks of years there was a jubilee year, when a great celebration took place and murderers were pardoned and allowed to leave their cities of refuge and return to their home towns (Leviticus 25:8).

This meant the 2nd Temple was began in 3428AM and Israel was given 7x 7y to rebuild the Temple and Jerusalem. When established they were given 70x 7y to live righteously under the Law, this was their second chance. Jerusalem and the Temple were rebuilt by 3477AM and they had until 3967AM when Jesus Christ was born in Bethlehem. (Deuteronomy 30:1-20 & forgiveness Matthew 18:21-22)

Jesus was crucified when He was 33y of age which was the 4000th year of Creation. This is significant because it parallels the 4 days sacrificial lamb for sin, found in Exodus 12. The lamb was chosen on the 10th and killed on the 14th at twilight. Jesus is the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world (Ephesians 1:4 2Timothy 1:9 Titus 1:2 1Peter 1:20 Revelation 5:6,9,12 13:8 17:8 20:12,15).

Adam was warned that he would die in the 'day' that he sinned, but he lived until he was 930y of age. This is the first reference to the 'week' allocated for this creation (2Peter 3:1-13). It is significant that Adam was 70y short of 1000y. Israel were 3x 70y in Egypt and 70y in exile in Babylon, so if 70y is the period of disobedience, that would make a total of 4 days in exile. Jesus died for the sins of the World after mankind's fourth day of disobedience. This day was the 3rd April 33AD which would mean that the 6000th year of Creation could be 2033AD? Much has to happen before then and the end will be a very traumatic period for those who are left alive on Earth after the 1st Resurrection has taken place.

There are two resurrections described in the Bible, the 1st Resurrection of the Righteous and the 2nd Resurrection of the Unrighteous. I have listened to many sermons on this and have come to the conclusion that for all the scriptures to be fulfilled Jesus will return three times, as holy events seem to take place in threes.

1st Return – The Barley Harvest

Jesus will return to fetch His body, the Church of Christ. His feet will not touch the ground and we will meet the Lord in the air. This event is described in 1Thessalonians 4:13-18 and also in Luke 21:36 "Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." (Revelation 3:3-6 7:9-17 20:4-6)

After this event the world descends into chaos under the rule of the Antichrist and the plagues described in Revelation take place. Those who have rejected Jesus Christ as their personal Saviour will have to suffer through this period for their faith. I believe these are the 144000 children of Israel described in Revelation 7:4-8 who faithfully keep the Laws of Moses given to them by the Word of God.

2nd Return – The Wheat Harvest

When Jesus returns for the second time it will be for the 144000, and to put all the unrighteous people to death. This is the horrific event of Revelation 19 as the unrighteous are 'written in the Earth'. This is described in Jeremiah 17:13 and Jesus acted this out in John 8:6 which as he did, the unrighteous departed.

Then the Millennial Sabbath begins; the righteous spend it in the New Jerusalem in Heaven and the unrighteous spend it in torment, in Hell under the Earth. This torment is described in Luke 16:23. Those unrighteous people will know they are lost without hope, and destined for the second death on Judgement Day.

3rd Return – The Grape Harvest

After the millennial Sabbath is over, Jesus will return to Earth with the Righteous. The second Resurrection takes place and the unrighteous people will be able to witness the Lord's return too – "Behold, He is coming with clouds and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him." (Revelation 1:7)

There is a short satanic rebellion which takes place and the Devil is thrown into the Lake of Fire. Then the Great White Throne Judgement takes place which is described in Revelation 20:7-15 & 21:8. All unrighteousness is annihilated in the Lake of Fire including Hell and Death, their spirits are destroyed. (Matthew 10:28)

The new Heavens and new Earth are created as described in Isaiah 65:17-66:24 and Revelation 21-22. Creation is remade perfect without sin and death, and there is no more sea on Earth. The New Jerusalem descends from Heaven onto the new Earth and here we will spend all eternity with GOD. Amen.

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
